General Transfer Credit & Study Abroad Policies for SM

Students transferring from another college or university to the U-M School of Kinesiology are permitted to transfer up to 70 hours from a four-year school and up to 60 hours from a two-year school or 62 credits from a two-year school with an associate's degree.

Appropriate transfer credits earned at accredited institutions will be accepted by Kinesiology provided a grade of "C" (2.000) or higher has been earned in the course(s) to be transferred.

Grades and grade point averages do not transfer (with the exception of transfer credit from U-M Flint and U-M Dearborn), and do not appear on the Kinesiology transcript.

All current SM Kinesiology students must take major requirements in residence at UM Ann Arbor. Incoming transfer students may petition previous coursework for 100 or 200-level SM coursework. 300 and 400 level requirements and electives cannot be transferred.

SM students may not earn major specific credits through external study abroad. Some Kinesiology-led

programs may earn SM specific credit.

International internship experience may be accepted for SM 403 credits with approval.
